

PROPOSED ORDINANCE 24-20

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of the County of Faulkner, State of Arkansas. An Ordinance to be entitled: An Ordinance to establish the Federal COVID-19 Programs Interest Fund, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Faulkner County was selected to receive American Rescue Plan (“ARP”) funds from the United States federal government in the amount of \$24,475,383; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish a fund to track the revenues, expenditures, and appropriated transfers of funds for the American Rescue Plan Interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas:

Section 1: There is hereby created on the books of the Faulkner County Treasurer and the books of the Faulkner County Clerk a County General sub-fund to be known as the Federal COVID-19 Programs Interest Fund with a fund number of 1803 as permitted for use by Arkansas Legislative Audit.

Section 2: The adoption of this Ordinance is an emergency and therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on May 22, 2024.
